Professor Dr Gabriele Spilker
University of Konstanz

Gabriele Spilker is Professor of International Politics with a focus on Global Inequalities at the University of Konstanz and Co-Speaker of the Excellence Cluster “The Politics of Inequality”. She completed her PhD at ETH Zurich and she was a Fritz Thyssen Fellow at the Weatherhead Center of International Affairs at Harvard University. She was a postdoctoral researcher at ETH Zurich, as well as Assistant Professor of International Politics and Empirical Research Methods at the Department of Political Science and Sociology of the University of Salzburg.

Her main research interests concern the determinants and the consequences of inequality. In particular, she focuses on the consequences of climate change for migration and conflict as well as inequalities in perceiving globalisation processes.
