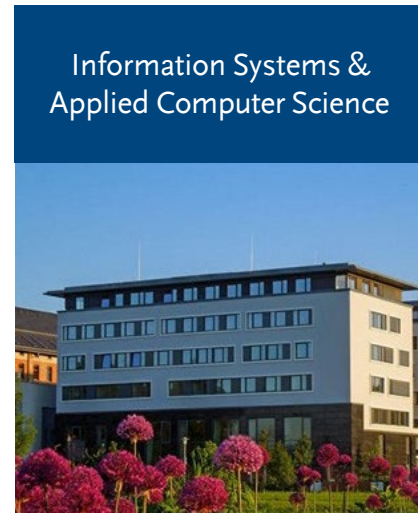

All incoming exchange students are offered a room in one of Bamberg's student residences as part of their exchange application



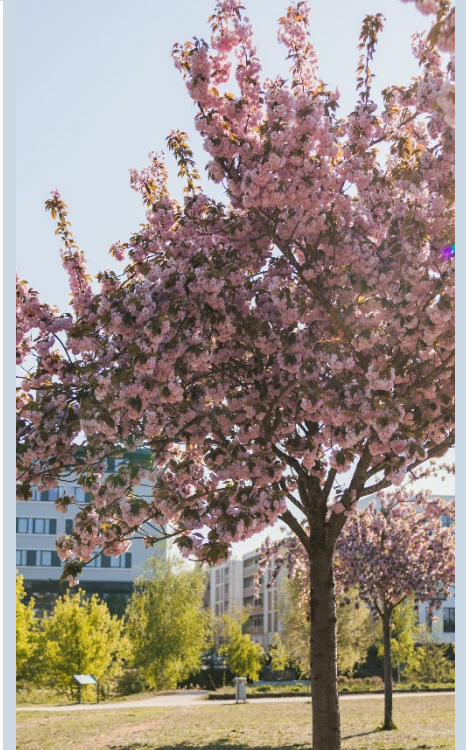
Tandem Program (Buddy Program)
