Requirement profile:

- Master or PhD degree with strong empirical focus (e.g. psychology, sociology, human-computer interaction, human factors, etc.) is a pre-requisite
- Experience in Human-Computer Interaction (HCI) and especially in User Experience and Usability Engineering with ideally knowledge of Computer-Supported Cooperative Work (CSCW), or Mobile and Ubiquitous Computing is a bonus
- Knowledge of and experience with quantitative empirical methods
- Experience with statistical software (e.g.: SPSS, R)
- Good command of English (and willingness to learn German)
- Experience in macOS is a bonus
